

Cervical Cancer Screening (CCS)

Measure Description: The percentage of women 21–64 years of age who were screened for cervical cancer by one of the following methods:

- Age 21-64: cervical cytology (Pap test) in 2016, 2017 or 2018
- Age 30-64: who had a cervical cytology/human papillomavirus (HPV) co-testing performed every 5 years. test with dates of service <5 days apart in 2014-2018

Applicable Provider Specialty: Mixed Specialty

Attribution Description: Members are attributed to practices with which they had at least one visit in 2016 or 2017.

Denominator Definition: Women 24-64 years of age as of December 31, 2018 who met continuous enrollment criteria for three years

Qualifying Exclusions: Women who had a hysterectomy with no residual cervix, cervical agenesis or acquired absence of cervix on or before December 31, 2018

Numerator Definition: A claim or encounter for:

- Cervical cytology (Pap test) during 2016, 2017 or 2018 OR
- For women 30 years and older, both cervical cytology (Pap test) and Human Papillomavirus (HPV) test from 2014-2018 with service dates <5 days apart
